**Coecles Harbor, Shelter Island NY (East end of Shelter Island)**

**High tide at Sag Harbor is 1:39pm low tide at 8:03 pm.**

**(VERY IMPORTANT TO HONOR ENTRANCE BUOY, FI G, N 041\* 04.08' /W 072\* 16.20')**

**Note: The entrance channel is VERY narrow (8' deep) and only 5' deep along one side and 1' deep along the other. Be sure to run a straight line between green cans. Once you enter, pass Ram Island on your starboard side and turn north into the mooring field. The moorings are small, white balls and you'll see the beach and causeway just beyond. Moorings are free for diners at the Ram's Head Inn (No reservations, First come, first served).**

\*The Plan: (raft up, anchor, slips etc. dinner aboard or ashore, other activities)

- 1) The approach to CH is at a right angle, down a **NARROW** path from the entrance bell. There are many areas shoaled in with sand, mind the dominant color of channel markers!!
- 2) Moorings are free and not reserved but we have a short sail and it's mid week everyone should get one
- 3) This is a secluded remote area so **NO** shower facilities or shopping is/are available without a dink or uber ride. See me for info if you feel so inclined.
- 4) After a long day of swimming, sunning and exploring on our private(Rams Head) beach we can convene at the quaint, beautiful and air conditioned Rams Head Inn bar. 5:30 for cocktails followed dinner 'en plein-air' on the covered patio overlooking our **FLEET!**

**You can go shopping in town or, if you want to explore the island, you can rent an electric golf cart (made to look like a sports coupe). Access to fun and adventures can be arranged by the nice people at Coecles Harbor Marina & Boatyard (631 749-0700). The marina is full service including fuel, repairs, showers, and laundry. The marina monitors VHF 9 and 12.**

## Communications:

1. VHF Radio Channel 72 is used by SUS for inter-boat communication.
2. Skippers cell phones may be used on occasion for communication.
3. It is recommended that each skipper check in with the lead skipper at 15 minutes after each hour and, for safety reasons, upon arriving at the scheduled destination.
4. Any skipper deviating from the planned sailaway destinations shall notify the lead skipper of that skipper's alternate destination.
