**Cost:** *TIPS for launch*

**Local Navigation Notes:** *Follow charts closely, especially Penfield Reef and entrance to Black Rock Harbor...rocks are unforgiving. From the west, pass to the south of Penfield Lighthouse (photo op as you can get fairly close). Do not turn to port until you pass the green buoy to the east of it. Then turn approximately heading 10° +/- toward the red daymark on the rock pile.*

*From the east there is deep water right up to the red daymark on the rock pile. Go (or stay) to the west of the red daymark and follow the red nuns.*

*From either the green buoy or the east approach you will see the white abandoned lighthouse. Head toward that, but switch to the west side of the red daymark as soon as you see the daymark.*
