1. Call to Order – Aija 7:05 pm

2. November Meeting Minutes – Lynne

- Will be updated to remove reference to SUS providing access to outside alcohol;
 and prior Board approval will be required if event tickets are to exceed \$60
- Ida moved to accept, Aija seconded, all approved

3. Board Member Reports

- President's Report Aija
 - o Social gathering on February 20 agreed with Marie to be held at Sedona
 - Location yet to be announced for next Board meeting, March 14
 - o After discussion, decided 2024 Annual Meeting March 21 will be Zoom only
 - April 6 Meet the Skippers location is confirmed at USCG Auxiliary in Norwalk
 - o Program meeting April 18 location at Stamford YC issue if open to the public?
 - Note that half of the current Board is in their first term; we need to listen to new ideas be flexible, patient and understanding during this learning curve time

Commodore's Report – Peter

- How to track crew have completed MOC and DOC; Ida says this is done already
- o Ida will provide lists of members with MOC/DOC and Boating Certificates
- Issue whether Boating Safety Certificate numbers should also be collected
- Vice Commodore is responsible for MOC and DOC orientation; the actual work can be delegated; most of the MOC is now done by Tom Z
- o Skippers are not responsible for educating crew; are in favor of a Safety program
- Member application on the website says "subject to approval", but not enforced
- Skipper meetings are open to all in the club; Andy will attend as a regular member listening and adding possible new ideas, and not as a representative of the Board
- Minutes of Skipper meetings will again be posted to the web after stopping in 2020
- Meeting minutes are stored for reference in OneDrive, maintained by Ida
- o An in-person event was scheduled for March 23, winter walk at Tod's Point

- Vice Commodore's Report Bill (written report submitted)
 - Vice Commodore Committee (CVC = Annie, Ronnie, Andy) was formed to create a survey of members' interests; Andy is researching relevant software
 - Much Board input on question if should it be limited to OTW (on the water) interests only, or should it also ask member preferences as to social activities
 - Bill suggests the mission of SUS is to maximize OTW participation by scheduling multiple activities on the same day, with focus and in support of these four areas:
 - Overnight sail-aways and anchor-out get togethers
 - Day sails and twilight sailing
 - Racing
 - Cruising (4 to 8 days)
 - Skippers will not provide education, but provide links to relevant public videos
 - o Board agrees that the Scope and method of member survey is still a work in progress

• Vice President – Andy

- After lengthy discussion and with some regret, Board voted to hold the Annual Meeting on March 21 by Zoom only. Issues and lessons learned:
 - Meeting can be boring and sparsely attended; how to make it more engaging
 - While legally required to be held, the 2024 room rental expense, cost of refreshments and effort required outweigh the benefit of in person meeting
 - For 2025 meeting, start to plan for it in the Fall; location, fun activities
- Andy is investigating if his RE/MAX office in Westport can be used for future Board and Skipper meetings
- As the Board position responsible for Programs is vacant, more input and help is needed from other Board members

- There is only one category of membership; no "emeritus" classification exists for social-only members or for those who can no longer physically participate
